Dear Parents,

We just wanted to share our pick up and drop procedures with everyone before our first day of camp.

MORNING DROP-OFF

Our camp day starts at 9:30AM. Staff members will be at camp each day by 9:15AM to help transition the children onto the campgrounds. We will be continuing our 'Valet Pick-Up' system. We ask that all parents pull their cars into the car line, beginning at the entrance gate next to the A-Frame building. Staff members will be waiting to help your camper out of your car and escort them onto the campgrounds. Counselors will be stationed at the gazebo, playground, and gaga courts to greet and supervise the campers as they arrive.

Each morning at 9:40AM, the entire camp community will meet at the flagpole for a morning line-up. Any child that arrives to camp after 9:40 should be brought to the office to sign-in. Afterwards, your child will be escorted by a staff member to their group to put their bag away and will then join their group at their activity area.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

Each afternoon, at 4:15PM, the camp community will meet again at the flagpole to recap the day. If you plan to pick your child up early, please be sure to arrive before 4:10PM to sign your child out of camp in the office. Once line-up has begun, parents are asked to wait to pick up their child until they are dismissed. Please do not leave your car unattended in the carpool line.

Each carpool family will be given a "Camper Car Tag" by Tuesday to keep on your dashboard so we can identify you as someone authorized to pick up their child. You will be able to write your child(ren) name on the tag. If you have several people that are allowed to pick up your child, please ask us for enough tags.

ON-COLONY CAMPERS

If your camper lives on-colony, we ask that that parents gather at the Bocce Court. On-colony campers will be escorted by a staff member to the Bocce Courts to meet their parents.

CAR PICK-UP

Campers who are picked up by car will be escorted to the A-Frame area. Similar to morning drop-off, we ask that all parents stay in their cars to make dismissal quick and easy. Cars should line up on the street where a staff member will be standing to call children's names and escort them to your car. Counselors will be there to ensure campers are safely monitored getting into cars.

As always, with a new camp season beginning, there are bound to be a few wrinkles to iron out the first few days. Please be patient with us during the first week of camp - thank you!
